## **The Garage Letting Criteria**

- 1) The applicant has to be living in Cardiff, and priority will be given to residents within 1 mile of the garage site.
- 2) If no waiting list exists then garages are let on a first come first served basis.
- 3) The garage unit can only be used for storing a vehicle or items that are not of a flammable nature. Cardiff Council will not be held responsible for any damage that occurs to the contents of a garage and garage tenants are encouraged to take out their own insurance.
- 4) If a garage site serves a high-rise block of flats or the site is attached to a low-rise block of flats, then that particular garage is subject to the Local Garage Lettings Initiative (preference to be given to residents who currently live in the high rise/low rise block). If there is no one on the list who live in the blocks, then the remaining applicants on the waiting list will be considered in date order.
- 5) An applicant can only rent one garage unless there are no other applicants on the waiting list for the area.
- 6) The applicant may only rent a garage providing they have no debt outstanding to Cardiff Council.
- 7) The applicant is only allowed to park their vehicle in the garage and this does not entitle them to park on the forecourt in front of the garage.
- 8) The applicant cannot make any structural alterations to the garage.
- 9) The applicant cannot sub-let, exchange or part with possession of the garage.
- 10) Either party may terminate a garage tenancy at any point after giving 4 weeks notice. Tenants can do this at any Council Hub.
- 11) Cardiff Council reserve the right to reject garage applications for any reason they see fit.
