

CO18273 Waterloo Road – Tabled Zebra Crossing

Consultation Report

September 2021

Introduction

Public consultation was undertaken on a proposal to introduce a tabled zebra crossing on Waterloo Road around its junction with Melrose Avenue in the Penylan Ward. The public consultation was undertaken between 18/06/2021 and 02/07/2021.

Consultation Activities

The following activities were undertaken to promote consultation:

- Letter drop to properties in the vicinity of the scheme
- Site notices in the vicinity of the scheme
- Email to stakeholders and statutory consultees
- Information on Council Website

Consultation Results

16 individual responses were received during this public consultation, a breakdown of these responses are as follows:

15: Support, and support with additional suggestions

1: Unclear, requested additional information

Supportive Comments

A number of residents welcomed the proposed changes, stating that this is a location where a high number of pedestrians and school children cross the road and this will create a safe location for users to cross the road.

Consultation Outcome

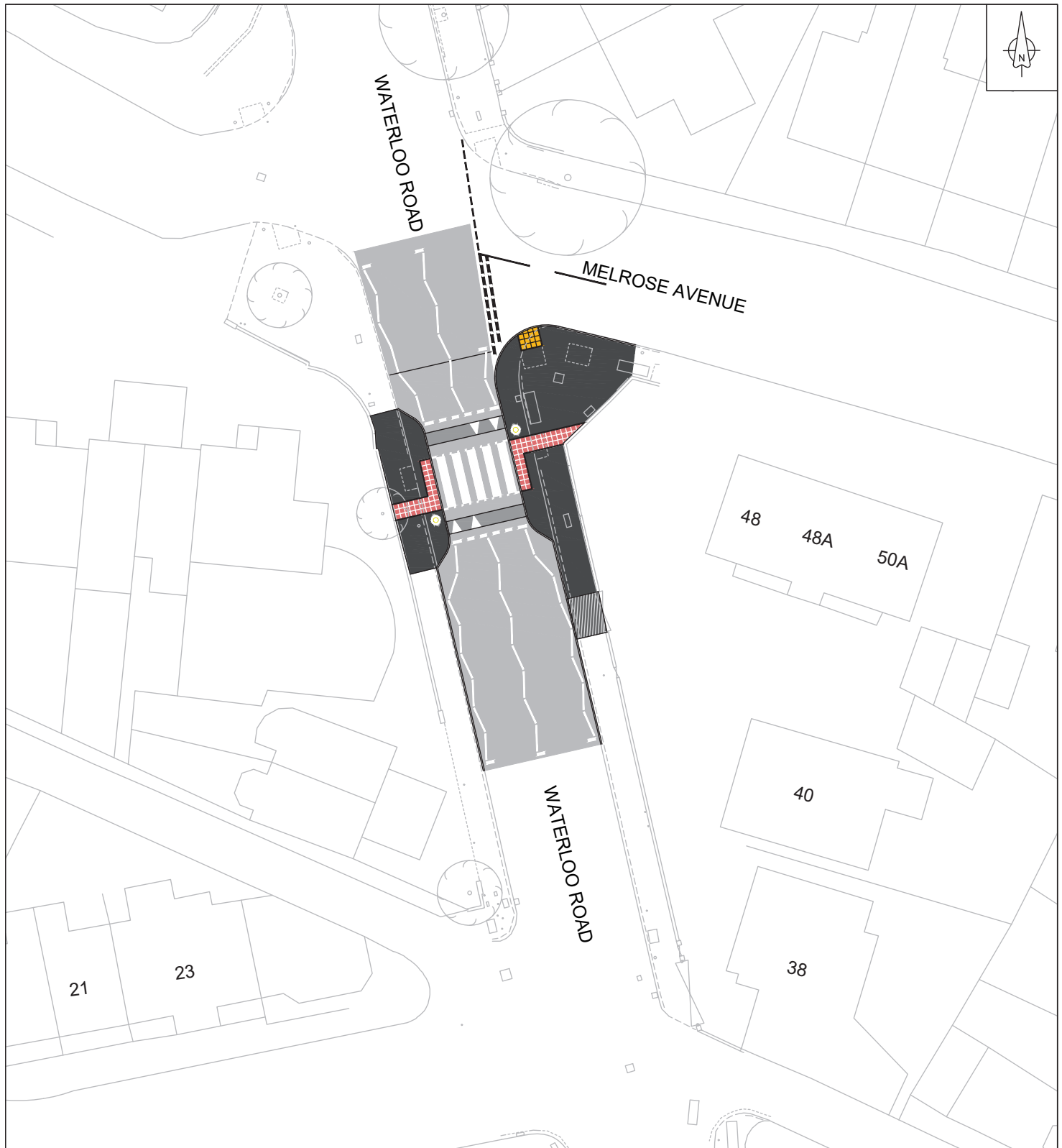
In view of the public consultation it is proposed to **proceed** with the proposal as shown on the attached plan.

Specific Issues

Specific issues raised through the consultation are set out below with the Council's response, where the same issue has been raised by a different responder these have been grouped together.

Issue	Response
Concerns were raised that vehicles park close to the junction of Melrose Avenue on both sides of Waterloo Road and this obstructs visibility around the junction, therefore parking restrictions should be introduced around these junctions.	Following implementation of this scheme post scheme monitoring will be undertaken to identify if there is a requirement for double yellow lines to be introduced around these junctions. If there is a requirement for double yellow lines then this would pass through a separate Traffic Regulation Order consultation process.
A number of residents raised concerns in relation to the width of the junction of Blenheim Road and asked if the junction could be modified to make it safer for pedestrians.	We understand your concerns and will add this location to our database as an Area of Concern. This will be reviewed and taken into consideration if nearby road safety issues arise, or alternative funding becomes available.
One resident could not clearly identify the extent of the proposed zig zag markings on the original site notice.	Additional house numbers have now been added to the site notice which should clearly help identify the extent of the proposed zig zag road markings.
