Gorchymyn Diogelu Mannau Cyhoeddus (CTY55) Letty Street (5-21) – Catherine Street (6-16), Cathays, Caerdydd
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Hysbysir Drwy Hyn Fod Cyngor Sir Dinas a Sir Caerdydd ("y Cyngor") ar 30 Mehefin 2026 wedi gwneud y gorchymyn uchod dan Adran 59, Deddf Ymddygiad Gwrthgymdeithasol, Troseddu a Phlisma 2014 ("y Ddeddf") a'r holl bwerau galluogi eraill.

Public Spaces Protection Order (CTY55) Letty Street (5-21) – Catherine Street (6-16), Cathays, Cardiff

Notice Is Hereby Given That The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff (“the Council”) has on 30th June 2026 made the above order under Section 59 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers

The effect of the order, which will come into force on 10th July 2026 will be to restrict, by the erection of barriers in the locations as described in the Order, all public access through:

The lane between rear of Ty Heulog, Fanny Street, and the rear of 5-21 Letty Street, and to the rear of 6-16 Catherine Street, Cathays, Cardiff. (“the Restricted Area)

at all times, with the exception of those persons exempt under the Order for the purpose of reducing crime and anti-social behaviour in “the Restricted Area”.

A copy of the Order can be seen on the Council’s website at www.cardiff.gov.uk/Alleygating. A copy of the order and a plan are available on request by email PSPO@cardiff.gov.uk or by writing to the address below. A person may apply to the High Court for the purpose of questioning the validity of the Public Spaces Protection Order on the grounds that that Council had no power to make the Order or that any procedural requirement was not complied with in relation to it. An application must be made within six weeks from the 30th June 2026 to the High Court for this purpose.
